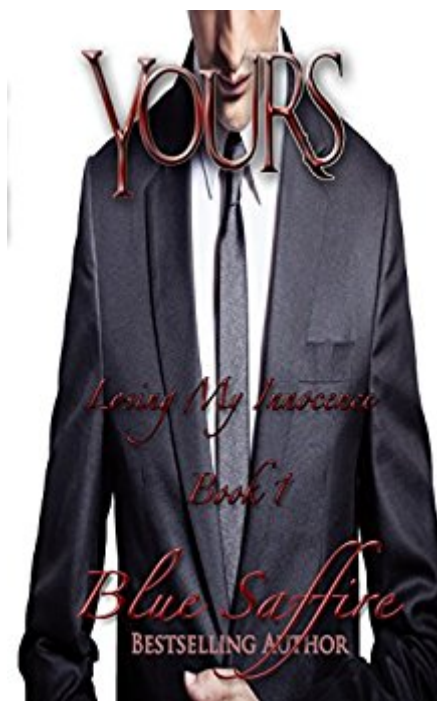


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Yours Book 1: Losing My Innocence

In this book, Sophi is losing her innocence while gaining everything else. You can really tell that Nick really loves her and care for her as he's been patiently waiting 4 years to get with her. It is expected for Sophi to be a little naive since all she's has done in her life was school and getting good grades. She didn't have a boyfriend or went out to clubs or truly experience college live, so it is expected for her not to know everything. Also, Sophi is a good and strong female lead in her own

way. No one can truly say what they'll do when confronted with being a dom/sub until it happens to them. I really want to know what darkness truly made Nick, Luke, Andrew, and the crew to dive into this lifestyle. Now, the mom really got on my nerves, especially how she would downgrade her own daughter while uplifting another person. It's understandable how Sophi can feel like she's not good enough when you're told that by the one person who should be your champion. I can wait to see what happens to Jillian in book two and to see how all this plays out. I would recommend this book and looking forward to finishing this series.

This is a really good read. I love the characters. I didn't like the heroine at first but Blue's characters are so complex, the heroine will start to grow on you. You experience her change as her self esteem grows. You will get pulled into the story from page 1. I must admit I was somewhat leery about this series as I don't really like or read stories with BDSM themes but "Yours" is love story/mystery that just has tastefully written scenes with some BDSM. It's not the focal point of the story nor it the focal point of the hotter than hot sex scenes between the two main characters. If this is your first novel by Blue Saffire I encourage you to read all her previous books. This young author is a rising star.

While this was a good book I am not sure how I feel about this book. I am currently reading book 2 in the series and I'm still uncertain about this series. I am not use to such an immature female lead character from Ms. Blue. The character is not only chronologically young but very mentally young and extremely immature. I know the reader is supposed to watch her grow and mature but there has been no growth with this character. I think the author was aiming for innocence but this was too much. Sephora is simply naive and while a genius, she is very emotional like a teenager and very dumb. Sephora is a child in every sense of the word. And bc she is so dumb and childish, the sex scenes, while well written, and very hot, are painful to read bc of the immaturity of this character. If this character were not of age chronologically, those scenes would be obscene and illegal. It is very difficult to imagine this character as an executive, a leader of her own team; a supervisor, in a relationship, or doing anything that doesn't require parental supervision. Wow. This character is too much of a child in the body of a woman. I love this author, I have never given her a bad review, and all of her books are excellent, but this book, this book is something else. I don't even know how to rate it and that's a first for me. While I love this author, if there is no growth before the end of book 2, I won't be following this series. I don't even know if I can recommend this book and I think the 3 stars I gave it might be too high.

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
